

PROGRAMME FOR NURSES

The National Kidney Foundation Malaysia began its Post Basic Haemodialysis Nursing Programme in its training centre in 2005 to create more qualified nurses to work with dialysis units and patients.

Last year, NKF received full accreditation for the PBHD programme by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency, as well as full recognition by the Government.

The six-month-long programme is open to nurses who have completed their three-year basic nursing programme and two years working experience as a staff nurse (out of which three months have to be in a dialysis unit). Visit <http://nkf.org.my>.
