

# NKF to Expand Its Accredited Nursing Programme

The National Kidney Foundation (NKF) Malaysia received full accreditation last year by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency for its Post Basic Haemodialysis (PBHD) Nursing Programme. This programme, which produces qualified nurses to work with dialysis units and patients, is fully recognized by the Malaysian government. In 2018, NKF announced that it would conduct two intakes for the PBHD programme, with plans already underway to increase both the number of intakes per year as well as the number of nurses per intake.
