MESSAGE FROM CHIEF EDITOR

Welcome to our 3rd issue for 2012.

We are delighted to announce that we officially received our 2nd LifeCheck Mobile Health Screening Unit from the Sunway Group. Our sincere thanks to the Sunway Group for supporting NKF's effort to create awareness on the importance of early detection and prevention of kidney and kidney associated diseases among the rural communities. Together we can contribute to the building of a healthy society and a healthy nation in line with our LifeCheck tagline "Early Detection and Prevention Saves Lives".

Every year, more than 4,000 Malaysians are diagnosed with kidney failure. The number of dialysis patients in Malaysia has tripled in 10 years from 7,837 in 2001 to 22,932 in 2010. Kidney disease, diabetes and high blood pressure are silent killers. Unless one goes for health screening, they are unlikely to be detected early. In Malaysia, 56% of new dialysis patients were diabetic and 8% were hypertensive in 2010.

NKF has been championing the fight against kidney and kidney associated diseases through education and screening. The NKF LifeCheck Mobile Health Screening Program brings health screening directly to the members of public in order to achieve greater impact. This community service has been well received and as at July 2012, NKF has screened more than 150,000 members of the public.

In this issue, we also highlight the official opening of our 25th dialysis centre in Kemaman, Terengganu, as well as the relocation of our dialysis centre in Taiping, Perak.

Our Public Education Department has continued to focus on our dialysis patients and we provided two (2) cooking demonstrations to teach them how to prepare a low potassium diet. We also share with you our handicraft and exercise sessions conducted for the patients. Please pass the word around and encourage more dialysis patients to take advantage of these free classes specially organised for them.

Once again, our sincere appreciation to all our sponsors and donors for helping us to provide subsidised dialysis care to kidney failure patients as well as helping us to reach out to the larger community to provide preventive health screening to continue our vision to save lives.

The Dialysis Diet: “Potassium VS. Phosphate”

Both ‘potassium’ and ‘phosphate’ are minerals found in most of the foods we eat, and one of the functions of our kidneys is to control the amount of both these minerals in the blood. However, the potassium and phosphate can build-up to high levels in the blood in patients with kidney disease.

High potassium levels in blood leads to other complications such as body weakness, muscle cramps, breathing difficulty, irregular heartbeats and - worst of all, heart attack.

In addition, high phosphate levels in the blood also increases the risk of one having weak and brittle bones, itching, as well as calcium deposits in blood vessels and other organs in the body.

It is essential for dialysis patients to understand the type of foods that contains potassium and phosphate and that some foods contain high levels of both minerals – double danger!

Dialysis patients will be able to better self-manage their condition and diet upon understanding useful tips regarding foods and their mineral contents, especially the double dangers as these are best avoided or to be consumed in very small amounts.



Most of the high potassium foods come from plants; therefore certain fruits and vegetables tend to be high potassium sources.

On the other hand, foods that are high in phosphate include meat, poultry, fish and seafood variety. It is also important to note foods which fall under the double danger category (high in both potassium and phosphate) which include dairy products, nuts, seeds, chocolate and wholegrain products.

A SECOND CHANCE IN LIFE

For Soon Hong, it started off with non-stop vomiting and migraine. A check-up at the local clinic indicated that there was a sudden surge in his blood pressure. Within a few days, he was hospitalized and diagnosed with endstage kidney failure. He was only 22 years old then.



Wong Soon Hong is a 27 years old young man from Ipoh, Perak. Affectionately known as 'Baby' by the elderly dialysis patients, he used to dialyze at Moral Uplifting Society – NKF Dialysis Centre in Ipoh for 4 years before he underwent the kidney transplant surgery in 2011.

"It really came as a shock, from what seemed to be just a common illness, to kidney failure," recalls Soon Hong as he shows the scars and bumps on his arms from previous dialysis treatments.



"There was this heavy weight on my chest when the doctors told me that my kidneys are failing. I was in pain and my family members were worried. Then, the doctors suggested kidney transplantation."

Soon Hong felt blessed when his mother and cousin sister offered to donate their kidneys for the transplant surgery. "The support and kindness shown by both of them were heartwarming.

In the end, my mother donated one of her kidneys so that I can have a second chance in life."

Today, Soon Hong is recuperating from his transplant surgery.

He always visits his friends and staff at the dialysis centre and brings cheer to others.

"My mother's love gave me a future to look forward to. I don't know how to repay her kindness but I will always love her more."
