FIVE organisations have received a year-end gift of RM110,000 from Pikom, the National ICT Association of Malaysia. The funds were proceeds raised from the Pikom Annual Charity Golf 2011 organised by the association.

Representing OrphanCARE was its deputy president, Noraini Hashim, while NKF was represented by its CEO Chua Hong Wee.

A representative from Asrama Harapan Baru Pitas received the cheque on behalf of the hostel.

"This is the fourth charity golf event that Pikom has organised since 2008.

As in previous years, this year's game was another resounding success and we are pleased that we are able to lend a hand to five organisations through the collective support of our sponsors and members who participated in the event.
