Kidney failure on the rise

2,500 cases diagnosed each year

AN ALARMING number of new kidney failure cases are diagnosed in Malaysia annually.

According to the National Kidney Foundation, the figure stands at about 2,500.

NKF chief executive officer Goh Seng Chuan announced the figure at the launch of the *Clean And Protect To Save Lives* charity campaign at Taman Bukit Maluri, Kuala Lumpur recently.

The campaign initiated by MySofa Cleaning Services contributes 5% of the value of all sales invoices to the NKF.

The entire proceed from the

first 20 clients on the launch day was also channelled to the foundation.

The NKF is a non-profit organisation offering subsidised dialysis treatments to poor kidney patients who pay a subsidised rate of RM50 per dialysis session.
