

Tee off in aid of dialysis patients

ALL set to swing for a good cause, the Rotary Club of Damansara (RC Damansara) announced The Swing for Charity Golf Event which will be held in aid of the National Kidney Foundation (NKF) of Malaysia.

The event, conceived in line with the Rotary Club's International theme for the Rotary Year 2016/17, "Rotary Serving Humanity", aims to raise RM50,000 to purchase another dialysis machine for NKF after

receiving a donation from CQ Tec-Breyer Group of Colleges to buy one dialysis machine.

Before the launch, NKF chief executive officer Chua Hong Wee (*pic*) said: "NKF cares for 1,500 patients at 26 dialysis centres throughout the country and provides subsidised treatment to them; all of which are generated through fundraising.

Hence, we welcome with open

arms any effort by Malaysians to help us."

RC Damansara president Anna P. Raj said: "This year's cause is very personal to me as I recall my late father's experience with dialysis. I am grateful that the committee identifies with the cause and we are looking forward to help purchase the machine for NKF."

The event is anticipated to garner 120 participants and is set to take

place on Oct 9 at the Bukit Jalil Golf & Country Resort with guest-of-honour Minister of Finance II Datuk Johari Abdul Ghani tee-ing-off.

Registration is now open with a participating fee of RM2,000 per flight. Registration closes on Sept 26 at 6pm.
