Toyota Classics in November

TOYOTA Classics returns this year and promises to delight audiences with its "Music that Moves Lives" one-night gala performance at the Dewan Filharmonik Petronas, Kuala Lumpur on Nov 11.

The fund-raiser will be graced by Selangor ruler Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamad Ali.

Celebrating its 25th anniversary this year, Toyota Classics 2014 will feature the Covent Garden Soloists Orchestra with violin prodigy Vasko Vassilev and piano soloist Pamela Nicholson under the direction of conductor Miguel Angel Navarro.

Aside from Malaysia, the performance will also tour cities in Singapore, Cambodia, the Philippines, Brunei, Thailand and Vietnam.

Tickets are priced at RM220, RM170, RM120 and RM60 and can be bought from Dewan Filharmonik Petronas box office.

Funds raised will be used to support the Lung Foundation of Malaysia, the National Kidney Foundation and Pertubuhan Kebajikan dan Perlindungan Nur Qaseh Malaysia.
