

Toyota Classics 25th anniversary



» Toyota's annual philanthropic classical music concert celebrates its quarter-century mark

UMW Toyota Motor Sdn Bhd marks a major milestone this year as the firm gears itself up for the 25th edition of its annual Toyota Classics philanthropic classical music concert.

Headlining this year's edition of the Toyota Classics is the Covent Garden Soloist Orchestra ensemble from London, with virtuoso soloists Vasko Vassilev and Pamela Nicholson. Additionally, world-renowned conductor Miguel Angel Navarro will conduct the stellar ensemble. Carrying the theme "Music that Moves Lives", Miguel Navarro will be leading the orchestra in showcasing original arrangements that include movie theme songs from classic western movies and modern-day blockbusters. This mark's the annual orchestra's first time at featuring such an arrangement inspired by films.



Since 1990, the annual concert has successfully raised funds totalling more than RM7 million from its ticket sales for more than 56 charitable organisations within Malaysia. This year's concert is set to raise funds for the Lung Foundation of Malaysia, the National Kidney Foundation, and Pertubuhan Kebajikan dan Perlindungan Nur Qaseh Malaysia organisation.

The one-night performance gala is scheduled to take place in the Dewan Filharmonik Petronas (DFP), KLCC on Nov 11. Open to members of the public, tickets are available in four tiers priced at RM60, RM120, RM170, and RM220. Presently, tickets can be purchased from DFP's box office located in KLCC.
