

National Kidney Foundation donates medical supplies

KUALA LUMPUR: The National Kidney Foundation of Malaysia donated medical supplies to the Health Ministry, including surgical gowns, Personal Protective Equipment and face masks as well as 17 haemodialysis machines to ensure proper treatment of kidney patients. Chairman Datuk Dr Zaki Morad Mohamad Zaher said: "The Covid-19 pandemic has led to an overwhelming number of patients in government hospitals and we recognise the urgency to respond and act swiftly to address the country's needs at this critical time."
