HAEMODIALYSIS INDUCTION COURSE

a three-month course | one intake yearly

Aims of the course

This course will develop the skills, knowledge and attitude of the trainees which will make them a part of a safe, effective and caring dialysis team.

Course Subjects

- Basic Medical Science
- Technical Aspects in Haemodialysis
- Care of Patient in Haemodialysis

Selection Criteria and Procedure

Candidates are recruited on the basis of their relevant merits and abilities as evaluated by the training team.



Certification

A Certificate of Competency will be awarded to those trainees who have successfully completed the course and pass the examinations.

Course Fee

RM2,500.00 payable to **National Kidney Foundation of Malaysia.**
*The course fee does not cover accommodation / transport / food during the training period.

Entry Requirements

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) • Had a minimum of one (1) year working experience in a haemodialysis unit. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diploma in Nursing • Registered with the Malaysian Nursing Board (MNB) • Possess a current Annual Practicing Certificate (APC) for nurses 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The candidate must be certified medically fit by a registered medical practitioner within ONE (1) month from commencement of the programme. • The candidate with any of the following medical conditions cannot be admitted into the programme such as: HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, mental health disorders, epilepsy and colour blindness. • The sponsored candidate must have full secondment and a form of endorsement from their employer, which must be attached with the application. • Self sponsored candidates are also welcomed to apply.

Lectures are given by senior dialysis tutors. Tutorials will be conducted regularly.

Clinical Practice

Clinical experience will be gained primarily in the NKF haemodialysis centres in Kuala Lumpur and Petaling Jaya.

Library

A comprehensive selection of text books and journals covering the aspects of haemodialysis is available in the training centre.

Course Evaluation

Evaluation is based on formative (continuous) and summative (final exam) assessment of theory and practice.

Training Programme

The course will be conducted on a full-time basis at the NKF Training Centre, Petaling Jaya. A visit to a Water Treatment Plant will be organised to get an in-depth view of water treatment.
