POST BASIC HAEMODIALYSIS NURSING PROGRAMME

Course Duration: 6 months | Two intakes yearly

Aims of the course

This course will develop the skills, knowledge and attitude of the registered staff nurses who attend this course, which will make them a part of a safe, effective and caring dialysis team.

Selection Criteria and procedure

Candidates are recruited on the basis of their relevant merits and abilities as evaluated by the training team.

Certification

NKFM will award a Post Basic Haemodialysis Nursing Certificate to those registered staff nurses who have successfully completed the course and pass the examinations.

Activity Highlights

- Clinical experience will be gained primarily at NKF centres under local preceptors.
- An educational visit to water treatment plant will also be arranged for the students.
- Attachment to government hospitals under the Ministry of Health of Malaysia for 4 weeks.

Programme Modules

- Clinical Nephrology
- Technical Aspects in Haemodialysis Nursing
- Psychosocial Aspects and Professionalism in Nephrology Nursing
- Clinical Aspects in Nephrology Nursing
- Care of Patient in Haemodialysis
- Clinical Practice – 3 months

Lectures are given by nephrologists and senior dialysis tutors. Tutorials will be conducted regularly.

Clinical Practice

Clinical experience will be gained primarily in the NKFM haemodialysis centres in Kuala Lumpur and Petaling Jaya.

Library

A comprehensive selection of text books and journals covering the aspects of haemodialysis is available in the training centre.

Course Evaluation

Evaluation is based on formative (continuous) and summative (final exam) assessment of theory and practice.

Training Program

The course will be conducted on a full time basis at the NKFM Training Centre, Petaling Jaya.

Entry requirements

- Possess Diploma in Nursing from a recognised institution by Malaysian Nursing Board (MNB).
- Registered with the MNB.
- Possess current Annual Practising Certificate (APC) for nurses from MNB.
- Minimum two (2) years clinical working experience.
- The candidate must be certified medically fit by a registered medical practitioner within one (1) month from commencement of the programme.
- A person with any of the following shall be disqualified from entry into a nursing programme:
 - Serious physical or mental illness, and/or
 - Serious communicable disease
- The candidate must not have any physical disabilities or impaired senses that hinder nursing dexterity.
- Pregnancy is not allowed throughout the course.

Course Fee

RM6,500.00 (0% GST) payable to National Kidney Foundation of Malaysia
